Articles of Organization

(General Laws, Chapter 180)

ARTICLE I

The exact name of the corporation is:

Big Little Life Animal Rescue International Inc

ARTICLE II

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in the following business activities:

The corporation is formed for the purpose of rescuing homeless, abandoned, and abused animals domestically and throughout the Russian Federation, by maintaining a no-kill animal shelter in Russia, providing long-term care for animals not appropriate for adoption, providing foster homes for animals unable to live in a shelter, providing necessary veterinary care, improving the temperament of ill-tempered animals by training, aiding in the rescue and rehabilitation of abused and abandoned animals, placing rescued and homeless animals into permanent adoptive homes, preventing cruelties of any form to any and all animals, and advocating for animal welfare in the community.

ARTICLE III

A corporation may have one or more classes of members. If it does, the designation of such classes, the manner of election or appointments, the duration of membership and the qualifications and rights, including voting rights, of the members of each class, may be set forth in the by-laws of the corporation or may be set forth below:

ARTICLE IV

Other lawful provisions, if any, for the conduct and regulation of the business and affairs of the corporation, for its voluntary dissolution, or for limiting, defining, or regulating the powers of the corporation, or of its directors or members, or of any class of members, are as follows:

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations described under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The corporation shall operate as a non-profit organization under the IRS 501(c)(3). The corporation shall have and exercise all powers conferred upon such organizations under Massachusetts State laws for non-profit corporations.

The corporation shall not conduct or operate for profit and no part of any profits or remainder residue from donations to the corporation shall be used to the benefit of any Director or individual. No sponsor, Director, officer, employee, anyone else associated with the corporation, or any private individual shall receive at any time any of the net earnings or profits from the operation of the corporation, provided, however, that these provisions shall not prevent payment to any such person or reasonable compensation for services performed for the corporation in effecting any of its public or charitable purposes, provided that such compensation is otherwise permitted by the Bylaws. No such person shall be entitled to share in the distribution of and shall not receive any of the corporations assets on the dissolution of the Corporation. The assets of the corporation shall be distributed as required by the Articles of Incorporation and not otherwise.

The duration of the corporate existence shall be perpetual until dissolution. The corporation may be dissolved by a unanimous vote of the Board of Directors at an annual or special meeting. Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for payment of any and all liabilities of this Corporation, dispose of all assets of the Corporation to a non-profit Corporation for the purpose of rescuing animals.

The nonprofit Corporation to which such assets go must be operated exclusively for charitable, educational, or scientific purposes and at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Service Code.

Notes: The preceding four (4) articles are considered to be permanent and may only be changed by filing appropriate Articles of Amendment.

ARTICLE V

The by-laws of the corporation have been duly adopted and the initial directors, president, treasurer and clerk or other presiding, financial or recording officers, whose names are set out on the following page, have been duly elected.

ARTICLE VI

The effective date of organization of the corporation shall be the date approved and filed by the Secretary of the Commonwealth. If a later effective date is desired, specify such date which shall not be more than *thirty days* after the date of filing.
